I hereby request that my child participate in the Junior Naturalist program. I understand and am aware that my child will be participating in many physical activities and that the potential for accidents does occur. In consideration of the Junior Naturalist program, the following statements apply:

- I indemnify and hold harmless the Okefenokee RESA and the Okefenokee Swamp Park, and/or its staff and volunteers from any and all liability, claims, damage, injury, or illness sustained by my child.
- I grant permission for The Okefenokee Swamp Park to provide or obtain medical attention for my child in the event of sickness or injury and I understand accident insurance is not included with the camp. Should a camper require special medical attention, prescriptions, or hospital care during the camp session, parent(s)/guardian(s) shall be contacted immediately and take over responsibility for treatment.
- My child may be participating in the following activities: cleaning and renovating animal enclosures, participating in educational programming, positive operant conditioning, and low boardwalk tours, etc. It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to ensure the camper is prepared to be outdoors and is wearing appropriate clothing and footwear, (for ex. play clothes and close toed shoes).
- I understand that to participate in the Junior Naturalist program, the \$20 daily fee will be paid the day of the event and that I am responsible for transportation to and from the Okefenokee Swamp Park.

- We expect Junior Naturalists to participate in all daily activities, in order to fully experience and enjoy the opportunities being provided.
